Box 483, Paonia, CO, 81428, has submitted a complete application for a technical revision to the Division of Reclamation, Mining & Safety for its approved Bowie No. 2 Mine, mining permit no. C-1996-083. Technical revision no. 108 will delete from the permit gob vent holes GVB-19A, 19B, 19C and associated roads. Most of the mine facilities are located north of Bowie Road near the old town of Bowie, CO. A pump station, three sediment ponds, the unit train loadout and a coal mine waste pile are located south of Bowie Road. The Fire Mountain Canal is located south of the mine facilities and north of the unit train loadout. The North Fork of the Gunnison River is located south of the mine permit boundary. The mine permit area is located on the U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute Bowie and Gray Reservoir Quadrangle maps within the following sections.
