## RE: Wyman Gravel Pit, Permit No. M-1983-037, Inspection Problem Abated

Dear Mr. Wyman:

On June 16, 2016 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site.

Hydrologic Balance was cited as a problem in the inspection report for exposed ground water and a well observed within the mine site. Corrective actions required that you demonstrate that the operation is in compliance with the Office of the State Engineer, show evidence that the operator is taking measures to bring the site into compliance with the SEO, or backfill the pits to at least two feet above the groundwater surface by the corrective action date specified by the corrective action date. On September 7, 2016 the Division received a letter from you. In that letter you provided photo documentation that the exposed ground water had been backfilled. Also included was documentation showing the well was under CDPHE's jurisdiction and not related to mining. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.

Revegetation was cited as a problem in the inspection report for the presences of state listed noxious weeds. Corrective actions required that you develop a weed control and management plan in accordance with Section 3.1.10 (6) of the Rule and provide photo documentation that weeds had been treated by the corrective action date. On September 7, 2016 the Division received a letter from you providing photo documentation that weeds had been treated. Also received was a weed management plan submitted as technical revision (TR-1). TR-1 was approved on September 12, 2016. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.
