The Division has identified several other comments and questions that must be addressed prior to the Division's decision due date. Please be advised that if you are unable to satisfactorily address any concerns identified in this review before the decision date, it will be your responsibility to request an extension of the review period. If there are outstanding issues that have not been adequately addressed prior to the end of the review period, and no extension has been requested, the Division will deny this Technical Revision.

6.4.8 Exhibit H – Wildlife Information

 The Division received comments from Boulder County Parks and Open Space in regard to wildlife surveys conducted at the Lyons Quarry. Please review the attached comments and explain how the Operator intends to address the concerns expressed by Boulder County Parks and Open Space.

6.5 Geotechnical Stability Exhibit

2. The final grading plan presented in Technical Revision No. 2 (TR02) does not appear to follow the recommendations in the Engineering Stability Analysis prepared by Kleinfelder in 2008. In order to proceed with the review of the Geotechnical Stability Analysis, the Division will require verification from Kleinfelder that the grading plan presented in TR02 meets the geotechnical specifications of the Engineering Stability Analysis (2008). The documentation from Kleinfelder shall include a P.E. seal. If the proposed grading plan does not meet the geotechnical specifications of the Engineering Stability Analysis, then a new analysis will need to be perpared.
