Dear Mr. Redmond:

On September 1, 2016 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) notified you of a complaint received. Hazardous materials was cited as a problem for based on photo documentation received showing several 50 gallon drums stored outside of secondary containment and contaminated soil.

Corrective actions required; photo documentation that any fuel or hazardous materials containers are stored properly - including applicable secondary containment structures. The operator may also provide photo documentation that all containers have been removed from the site on or before the corrective action date. Also please provide photo documentation that all contaminated soil was properly removed and provide a receipt showing that said material was properly disposed of by Friday, October 14, 2016.

On October 13, 2016 the Division received the above mentioned documentation. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.
