1. Please update the Exhibit C-1 map to portray the name and location of the Anadarko owned oil and gas wells, lines, and easements on the affected land and within two hundred (200) feet of the affected land pursuant to Rule 6.4.3(b) and (g).

2. Please provide an alternative Reclamation Plan Map with the expected physical appearance of Tract A – West Basin if a structure agreement to relocated the Anadarko oil and gas line is not obtained and the oil and gas line easement cannot be mined through by the Operator pursuant to Rule 6.4.6(a).

3. Please provided an affidavit or receipt indicating the date on which the revised application information required to address this adequacy letter was placed with the Weld County Clerk and Recorder for public review, pursuant to Subparagraph 1.6.2(1)(c).
