Please complete the attached technical revision form and include the required \$216 revision fee. Under the description of changes please write inert fill affidavit.

Include the following on your inert fill affidavit:

- A statement that imported material is inert fill as defined by Rule 1.1(20) "non-water soluble and non-putrescible solids together which such minor amounts and types of other materials, unless such materials area acid to toxic producing, as will not significantly affect the inter nature of such solids. Terms includes, but is not limited to, earth, sand, gravel, rock, concrete which has been in a hardened state for at least sixty days, masonry, asphalt paving fragments, and other inert solids.";
- a narrative that describes the approximate location of the proposed activity (where the material will be stored);
- the approximate volume of inert material;
- what the end use goal of the asphalt is (sold or used as structural backfill for reclamation);
- the approximate dates the proposed activity will commence and end, however, such dates shall not be an enforceable condition; an explanation of how the backfilled site will result in a post-mining configuration that is compatible with the approved post-mining land use;
- The document needs to include the permit number and be signed and dated.
