Dear Mr. Cooley:

As requested in our phone conversation on October 17, 2016, below is the information for the inert fill affidavit.

Please complete the attached technical revision form and include the required \$216 revision fee. Under the description of changes please write inert fill affidavit.

Include the following on your inert fill affidavit:

- A statement that imported material is inert fill as defined by Rule 1.1(20) “non-water – soluble and non-putrescible solids together which such minor amounts and types of other materials, unless such materials area acid to toxic producing, as will not significantly affect the inter nature of such solids. Terms includes, but is not limited to , earth, sand, gravel, rock, concrete which has been in a hardened state for at least sixty days, masonry, asphalt paving fragments, and other inert solids.”;
- a narrative that describes the approximate location of the proposed activity (where the material will be stored);
- the approximate volume of inert material;
- what the end use goal of the asphalt is (sold or used as structural backfill for reclamation);
- the approximate dates the proposed activity will commence and end, however, such dates shall not be an enforceable condition; an explanation of how the backfilled site will result in a post-mining configuration that is compatible with the approved post-mining land use;
- The document needs to include the permit number and be signed and dated.

As defined by the Minerals Rules, a Technical Revision (TR) is: “a change in the permit or application which does not have more than a minor effect upon the approved or proposed Reclamation or Environmental Protection Plan.” The Division is charged with determining if the revision as submitted meets this definition. If the Division determines that the proposed revision is beyond the scope of a TR, the Division may require the submittal of a permit amendment to make the required or desired changes to the permit.

The request for a TR is not considered “filed for review” until the appropriate fee is received by the Division (as listed below by permit type). Please submit the appropriate fee with your request to expedite the review process. After the TR is submitted with the appropriate fee, the Division will determine if it is approvable within 30 days. If the Division requires additional information to approve a TR, you will be notified of specific deficiencies that will need to be addressed. If at the end of the 30 day review period there are still outstanding deficiencies, the Division must deny the TR unless the permittee requests additional time, in writing, to provide the required information.

There is no pre-defined format for the submittal of a TR; however, it is up to the permittee to provide sufficient information to the Division to approve the TR request, including updated mining and reclamation plan maps that accurately depict the changes proposed in the requested TR.
