Dear Mr. Henderson:

On May 11, 2016 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Three inspection problems were cited.

Problem One: Availability of records, was cited as a problem. This was based on conversations with the operator, the site has been inactive since 2008. Corrective actions required the Operator file for Temporary Cessation. The start date of the initial 5 year Temporary Cessation period is retroactive to the date of the succession of operator approval or begin reclamation.

On September 28, 2016 the Mined Land Reclamation Board meet and considered your request for temporary cessation status. On October 24, 2016 the Division has accepted your notice. This matter is now considered abated.
