The Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) inspected the above mentioned site on August 17, 2016. Problem Two: Weeds were cited as problem. Corrective actions require the operator to submit a weed management plan in the form of a technical revision. The corrective action due date was October 31, 2016. Problem Three: Signs and Markers were cited as a problem. Corrective actions require the operator to get the site surveyed and replace the boundary markers in the correct locations. AND submit photo document proof by the corrective action date wich was October 31, 2016.

On October 31, 2016 a formal request for a 60 day extension was received from Stacy Quick. She noted that the Routt County weed manager had been contacted and she is working with him to develop a weed management plan. With regards to the boundary markers the surveyor has been contacted and she is waiting for him to go to the site and locate the boundary. The Division is approving the 60-day extension request.

To avoid potential future enforcement actions for non-compliance with State Statutes, Rules and Regulations, and/or conditions specified in your permit for this site, you must submit compliance documentation with the corrective actions specified by *Friday*, *December 30*, *2016*.
