Mr. Fabrizio:

On November 03, 2016, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) approved the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on October 11, 2016, addressing the following:

Move access road location from planned location on mine plan map exhibit C-2 to current "as built" location. Change to intermittent status to allow for mining activities to occur for less than 180 days each year.

The terms of the Technical Revision No. 02 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1993-004. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1993-004 remain in full force and effect.

The Division has determined that the currently held financial warranty in the amount of \$48,297.00 is sufficient to reclaim the site in accordance with the approved reclamation plan. Therefore, no additional financial warranty is required at this time.
