On November 21, 2016 The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your documentation demonstrating compliance with the problem cited in the Inspection Report dated July 22, 2016. The corrective actions were to submit in writing, a report characterizing the unknown materials identified in the inspection report. Upon receipt of the analytical report identifying the materials as inert, the Division considers the problem to be abated and no further action is necessary.

Furthermore, The Division has reviewed the Reclamation Cost Estimate for the site. Staff calculations find that the currently held Financial Warranty in the amount of \$29,902.68 is sufficient to achieve reclamation of the site.
