On November 21, 2016, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received Notice of Intent (NOI) to Conduct Prospecting Operations for Hard Rock/Metal Mines modification application (MD-02) from Climax Molybdenum, File No. P-2011-014. The Division reviewed the NOI modification for adequacy. Please address the following items:

- 1. Please select a Range direction on Page 2, Section I, Item #10 of the application form.
- 2. Please provide an estimate of the amount of material to be extracted, moved or proposed to be moved on Page 3, Section III, and Item #9 of the application form.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 5.1.2(m), please provide proof of notice of the NOI modification application to the Clear Creek Board of County Commissioners.

As required by Rule 5.1.3(c), the Prospector shall address all identified deficiencies or complexities within sixty (60) days of the Office notification. If the deficiencies or complexities are not addressed within sixty (60) days, the Office may terminate the NOI file. Please address the NOI modification application deficiencies indicated in this letter by February 17, 2017.
