## Re: Everist Materials, LLC; Cottonwood Quarry; Permit No. M-2004-061; Required Financial Warranty Assessment Inspection (S0-01); Weather Delay

Mr. Norwick,

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) approved the request for a Succession of Operator (SO-01) from Linke Construction, Inc. to Everist Materials, LLC for the Cottonwood Quarry on October 28, 2016.

The Division is required to conduct an inspection of the site within 60 days of approval to assess the amount of reclamation liability. However, due to the current weather conditions the inspection must be postponed until it is feasible for the Division to access the site and determine the reclamation liability.

The Division will contact the Operator as soon as weather conditions permit to determine a suitable date and time to inspect the site.
