

Pitch Well, Permit No. W-2903

Location: The well is described as being located at a point whence the East Quarter Corner of Section 25, T48N, R5E of the N.M.P.M., bears South 60° 17.3 ' West 16,279.57 feet distant.

On October 4, 1976 Homestake filed with the Colorado Water Division No. 4 for the right for water flowing from the 300 Level of the Pinnacle Mine and for future water that may be developed from the open pit Pitch Mine.
