The boundary of the pit is now clearly marked. I hired Leibert - McAtee & Associates, a local surveying firm, to go out and find the proper boundary based on GPS and feet measurements. At each corner of the boundary and the midpoint on the North boundary, they placed a pin at ground level and then drove a steel fence post beside each marker. So, there are 8 steel post with at least the top foot painted orange marking the boundary of the pit. This spring, when the ground thaws, I plan to replace the steel fence post with a more permanent post that cows will not knock over, as I believe that is what happened to the original markers. This should fulfill the requirements outlined in your inspection report.
