The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has issued a proposed decision to approve Bond Release Application No. 18 (SL-18) for the New Horizon Mine, Permit No. C-1981-008. The surface operation is operated by Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation, LLC under the provisions of the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act of 1979. The bond release application was submitted by Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation, LLC on January 26, 2016. WFC is requesting partial Phase I bond release on 23.5 acres on the former NE Haul Road and BB Road Detour which were regraded, topsoiled and seeded in accordance with the approved permit. The affected area is located in Montrose County, approximately 1.7 miles Northwest of Nucla, Colorado.
