OBSERVATIONS

This was an inspection of the Schumacher Pit #3, DRMS permit number M-2006-072, operated by Jeffrey L. Schumacher. I, Jared Ebert and Wally Erickson of the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety conducted the inspection. The weather was sunny and warm at the time of the inspection.

This inspection was conducted in order to evaluate the corrective action taken to address a problem cited during the Division's December 15, 2016 Inspection.

Signs and Markers:

During the Division's December 15, 2016 inspection, it was cited as a problem that the affected area boundary markers were missing or incorrectly placed. Since that time, the operator conducted a survey and replaced the boundary markers.

Each of the permit boundary corner markers were in place at the time of this inspection. Given this, the problem cited during the Division's December 15, 2016 inspection is considered resolved at this time.
