The applicant, Lowell Staats Mining Company, by its attorney, Eugene H. Mast, First National Bank Building, Grand Junction, Colorado 81501, requests a change of legal description only on the Meander Ditch, Priority Nos. 267 and 314. Filed June 7, 1972.

FINDING OF FACT

The Meander Ditch is entitled to Ditch #209 and Priority #267 absolute not to exceed 2.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation purposes, as of historic date June 8, 1909, and decreed date October 22, 1926, and also to Priority #314 absolute by enlargement not to exceed .75 c.f.s. of water for irrigation purposes, with date of June 1, 1928.

Said ditch and the enlargement thereof divert their supply of water from Calamity Draw, and a small unnamed draw intersected by said ditch, both tributary to the San Miguel River in Water District #60 in Montrose County.

Said ditch has two points of diversion described in the original decree as Headgate #1, located at a point on the right bank of said Calamity Draw, whence the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 46 North, Range 15 West, N.M.P.M., bears North 46° 56' West 4365.7 feet.

Headgate #2 located at a point on the left bank of a small draw whence the northwest corner of said Section 6 bears North 47° 25' West 3953.5 feet.

The applicant who claims 2.0 c.f.s. of the above described right states that the legal description of the diversion point is erroneous in the original decree and that the actual point of diversion is, and has been for 35 years, a point described as ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF CALAMITY DRAW, APPROXIMATELY AT OR NEAR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 46 NORTH, RANGE 15 WEST, N.M.P.M.

No opposition has been filed.

RULING

IT IS THE RULING OF THE REFEREE that the statements made in the application are true, that the original legal description is erroneous, and that The Meander Ditch is APPROVED AND GRANTED a change of legal description only to read as above stated.
