On March 21, 2017 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your response via email, regarding the Problem identified during the inspection conducted at the Jemadojin Sand Mine in the October 11, 2016 inspection report. The Division has changed the status of the Corrective Action associated with the following cited Problem to be <u>resolved</u>:

Problem/Possible Violation: The mine identification sign was not posted at the entrance of the mine site. This is a problem for failure to post a mine identification sign as required by Section 3.1.12(1) of the rule.

The Operator submitted photographs showing the permit sign re-posted. Therefore, this Problem is considered resolved.
