## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) in response to the Succession of Operator (SO-2) application submitted on March 9, 2017. The current operator is Pioneer Sand Company and the prospective operator is 3B Enterprises LLC. The Rock Pit Mine is a 110c permitted site that includes a total of 9 permitted acres. This site is located approximately three and half miles southeast of Craig, Colorado. It is accessed from Moffat County Road 394 through a private driveway. No operator was present for the inspection but the prospective operator was contacted. Amy Yeldell of the Division conducted the inspection.

The mine identification sign and affected area boundary markers are in place and in compliance with Rule 3.1.12. The sign is located at the entrance to the permit boundary.

The site remains inactive and is currently in temporary cessation. No equipment, buildings or fuel storage were observed on site.

Vegetation was dormant at the time of the inspection. Staff was unable to determine if weeds are present though treatments later this summer are likely necessary. No signs of excessive erosion or other stormwater problems were observed.

Site conditions have not changed since the previous inspection in May of 2016. The bond was recalculated based on that inspection and resulted in a surety increase. Currently the Division holds a financial warranty amount of \$14,438 for this site which is sufficient.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
