Dear Mr. Taylor:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) is in the process of reviewing the Technical Revision (TR-2). In reviewing your file an outstanding problem for this site was identified.

The currently approved mining plan has a maximum disturbance of 10 acres. To date approximately 24.3 acres is affected by mining. Based on the commitment letter received December 6, 2017 approximately 10 acres will be reclaimed in 2017. This will result in approximately 14.3 acres of mining phases plus the access road. Please see the attached map.

It is the Divisions recommendation that while you are making changes to your permit that you also revise your mining plan to resolve this problem. <u>Requesting that the **maximum disturbance be 15**</u> **acres** will resolve this problem. In order to incorporate additional changes into TR-2 the Division must receive this request on or before **April 24, 2017**.

A decision due date has been set for April 27, 2017. There are no deficiencies with TR-2 as submitted with regards to revising the seed mix and updating the permit boundary.
