OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator wan not present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The BLM Olathe Pit is located approximately 5.5 miles southwest of Olathe and accessed from H-54 Road. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 4.8 permitted acres. Pursuant to Rule 4.1.2 (2), a financial warranty is not required for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was posted on a rock at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by a perimeter berm that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

There was no activity occurring at the site during this inspection. Use of this site by the operator appears to be infrequent. There is no equipment stored on site. Several small stockpiles of stone and dirt are located on the pit floor. There is a lot of trash throughout the site and adjacent area from public use and dumping.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
