On March 31, 2017 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety approved the Amendment application submitted to the Division on October 25, 2016, addressing the following:

Add 80 Acres

The terms of the Amendment No. 1 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-2011-004. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-2011-004 remain in full force and effect.

The revised liability amount is \$8,490.00. The Division received a surety irrevocable letter of credit (ILOC) for this amount prior to the approval of AM-01. The Division will now review the ILOC and inform you of any adequacy issues under separate cover. The revision will not be final until the bond is approved by the Division.

The Division received comments from both the Colorado Division of Water Resources and the State Historical Preservation Office. These letters are enclosed for your records.
