### **COMMENTS**

This was a complete inspection of the New Horizon Mine conducted by Brock Bowles of the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety. Frank Ferris and Tom Fry of Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation were present for the entire inspection. The weather conditions were overcast with occasional rain showers. Some areas of the mine were inaccessible due to muddy/slippery conditions. The temperature was approximately 50F and the ground was damp/muddy.

#### AVAILABILITY OF RECORDS – Rule 5.02.4(1):

The records were checked after the ground inspection. All required records were on file and available for review at the mine office. No problems were noted with the records review. Please see the availability of records at the end of this report.

#### FISH and WILDLIFE – Rule 4.18:

An otter was seen in pond 7 in the cattails on the south east corner.

#### HYDROLOGIC BALANCE - Rule 4.05

Drainage Control 4.05.1, 4.05.2, 4.05.3; Siltation Structures 4.05.5, 4.05.6; Discharge Structures 4.05.7, 4.05.10; Diversions 4.05.4; Effluent Limits 4.05.2; Ground Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Surface Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Drainage – Acid and Toxic Materials 4.05.8; Impoundments 4.05.6, 4.05.9; Stream Buffer Zones 4.05.18:

Pond 7 contained water but was not discharging (photo 1).

Pond 9 did not contain water.

Pond 12 was inaccessible due to wet soil conditions.

Pond 13 contained water and was discharging as was the trench drain. The emergency spillway was clear of obstructions. The embankment was recently cleared of vegetation (photo 2).

Number of <u>Partial</u> Inspection this Fiscal Year: 6 Number of <u>Complete</u> Inspections this Fiscal Year: 3 Pond 16 did not contain water. The inlet structures were in good condition (photo 3). The emergency spillway was clear of obstructions.

Pond 18 did not contain water. Fill was added to ditch C4A to prevent water from ponding in the ditch (photo 4). The emergency spillway was free of obstructions. Culverts C175 and C176 were unobstructed.

The weeds around culvert 118 were recently burned. Culverts 118-124 were clear of obstructions.

#### GENERAL MINE PLAN COMPLIANCE:

The diesel fuel storage tank was disassembled and prepared to be removed as it is no longer needed at the NH2 facilities area (photo 5).

The former northeast haul road and former topsoil stockpiles F and G were not inspected due to damp soil conditions.

#### SIGNS AND MARKERS – Rule 4.02:

The permit boundary signs were in place around the pond 7 outfall, by ponds 8, 9, 13, 16 and 18, the facilities area and irrigated pasture reference area.

TOPSOIL - Rule 4.06

Removal 4.06.2; Substitute Materials 4.06.4(4); Storage and Protection 4.06.3; Redistribution 4.06.4: The ring ditches and sediment traps were in place around the multiple piles of stockpile 12 (photo 6).

### **ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS/COMPLIANCE**

No enforcement actions were initiated as a result of this inspection, nor are any pending.
