COMMENTS

This was a partial inspection of the New Horizon North Mine conducted by Brock Bowles of the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety. Frank Ferris and Tom Fry of Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation were present for the entire inspection. The weather conditions were overcast with occasional rain showers. The temperature was approximately 50F and the ground was damp.

BACKFILL and GRADING - Rule 4.14

Contemporaneous Reclamation 4.14.1; Approximate Original Contour 4.14.2; Highwall Elimination 4.14.1(2)(f); Steep Slopes 4.14.2, 4.27; Handling of Acid and Toxic Materials 4.14.3; Stabilization of Rills and Gullies 4.14.6:

The Pond 002 North Ditch has been backfilled from the eastern edge of the permit boundary to the east side of the Pond 002 topsoil stockpile. This distance is approximately 2,200 feet. The backfill has been graded to approximate original contour that conforms to the rolling terrain. Drainage channels have been reestablished.

HYDROLOGIC BALANCE - Rule 4.05

Drainage Control 4.05.1, 4.05.2, 4.05.3; Siltation Structures 4.05.5, 4.05.6; Discharge Structures 4.05.7, 4.05.10; Diversions 4.05.4; Effluent Limits 4.05.2; Ground Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Surface Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Drainage – Acid and Toxic Materials 4.05.8; Impoundments 4.05.6, 4.05.9; Stream Buffer Zones 4.05.18:

Pond 001 contained water but was not discharging (photo 1).

Pond 002 did not contain water. The north ditch of Pond 002 has been backfilled to just east of the Pond 2 topsoil stockpile. Straw wattles were installed on the downhill side of the reclaimed ditch in drainages (photo 2) and areas where the slope appeared to be steep (photo 3). A berm with a straw wattle filter was installed at the east end of the topsoil laydown area. This berm catches any topsoil runoff from going into sediment pond 002. The disturbed area around the topsoil stockpile still reports to Pond 002.

TOPSOIL – Rule 4.06

Removal 4.06.2; Substitute Materials 4.06.4(4); Storage and Protection 4.06.3; Redistribution 4.06.4:

Number of <u>Partial</u> Inspection this Fiscal Year: 6 Number of <u>Complete</u> Inspections this Fiscal Year: 3 Topsoil has been replaced over the backfilled areas of the Pond 002 north ditch. The topsoil was replaced to a depth of 2 feet in most areas (photo 4). Areas that received shallower depths of topsoil were identified by the soil profile made visible by the disturbance of the ditch. A ledge rock layer was the most common reason the top soil was shallow in certain areas. The topsoil on the reclaimed area had been ripped. ERMR is planning to rock pick the reclaimed area.

Topsoil for the Pond 002 north ditch was taken from the Pond 002 topsoil pile. The remaining part of the topsoil pile was recontoured, ripped and dimpled with dozer tracks (photo 5). The ring ditch was reestablished around the pile. The area from where the topsoil had been removed was recontoured, ripped and dimpled with dozer tracks.

No enforcement actions were initiated as a result of this inspection, nor are any pending.
