RE: Van 4 Shaft, Permit M1997032, Status of Temporary Cessation.

Dear Mr. Glasier,

On February 19, 2014 the Mined Land Reclamation Board approved Energy Fuels, Inc. request to put the Van 4 permit into an initial Temporary Cessation (TC) pursuant to Rule 1.13.5(1)(a) for five (5) years. Per the request the TC was effective June 13, 2012. Therefore, the TC period ends on June 12, 2017.

Pinon Ridge has three (3) options to address the conclusion of the initial period of TC and comply with the Act and Rules by June 12, 2017.

- 1) Re-commence mining operations that meet the definitions of CRS 34-32-103(8) and Rule 1.1 (31); or
- 2) Declare that the permit is entering into final reclamation pursuant to CRS 34-32-103 (6)
 (b). The declaration shall include a Technical Revision outlining the tasks and timeframes to accomplish reclamation to meet the five (5) year requirement of Rule 3.1.3(2).
- Request a hearing pursuant to CRS 34-32-103 (6) (a) (III) and Rule 1.13.5 (1)(b) for a second five (5) year TC period before the Mined Land Reclamation Board at the June 28th, 2017 MLRB meeting. The request must be received by no later than June 1st, 2017 and meet the requirements of Rule 1.13.5 (3).

Failure to initiate one of the three options outlined above by June 12, 2017 may result in the Division seeking enforcement action including but not limited to declaring the termination of life of mine and order final reclamation to commence.
