#### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The Carol Ann Pit is located immediately adjacent to the Gypsum Gravel Pit 1.5 miles east of Gypsum, Colorado off Highway 6. The site is a 112c operation that consists of a total of 30 acres. Chip Bair of B&B Excavating accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

The mine identification sign and the affected area boundary markers are in place and in compliance with rule 3.1.12.

The pit was inactive during the inspection and is mined out. Mr. Bair stated that the eastern boundary that is adjacent to the Gypsum Gravel Pit may be day lighted once an agreement between the two landowners is made.

No noxious weeds were observed during the inspection.

No off-site damage, problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.

The currently held reclamation bond in the amount of \$77,900.00 has been reviewed and deemed adequate to complete the approved reclamation plan.
