Dear Mr. Collins:

On April 25, 2017 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received the final documentation required for the completion of the above listed permit revision. Therefore, on April 27, 2017 the Division approved the Amendment application submitted to the Division on January 22, 2016, addressing the following:

Change post mining land use and alter reclamation plan to match. The Post mining land use has been changed to Industrial / commercial and the reclamation plan has been changed to allow the portals to remain open for landowner use, as well as the portal pad and access road to remain.

The terms of the Amendment No. 1 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1986-102. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1986-102 remain in full force and effect. Please note that according to records kept by the Division, minimal reclamation tasks remain to be completed. The reclamation tasks to be completed include a general but thorough site clean-up, and removal of all mining related equipment and debris from the portal pad area.

Once the Operator feels the reclamation has been completed in compliance with the amended reclamation plan he may apply for Final Release of the permit and its associated financial warranty. Enclosed with this Decision Document is the Request for Full Reclamation Liability Release form. To request the release, complete the form and submit it to the Division's Denver Office in accordance with Rule 4.17 of the Rules for the Extraction of Construction Materials for consideration.
