Mr. Lembke:

On May 1, 2017 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) approved the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on March 30, 2017, addressing the following:

Revised Mine Plan to increase the maximum allowable disturbance acreage from 30 to 70.85 acres.

The terms of the Technical Revision No. 4 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1982-112. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1982-112 remain in full force and effect.

The Division issued a Financial Warranty Increase Letter (SI-01) on February 1, 2017 related to the increase site disturbance acreage based on the February 18, 2016 inspection. The required Financial Warranty was increase by \$102,500.00 from the current financial warranty amount of \$44,146.00 for a total Financial Warranty of \$146,646.00. The current due date for posting the financial warranty increase is May 2, 2017. If you have not already done so, please submit the additional bond in the amount of \$102,500.00. The technical revision will not be final until the bond is approved by the Division.

The receipt and approval of the technical revision satisfies the corrective action required for the related problem cited in the Division's inspection report dated February 1, 2017.
