Re: Ignacio Pit, Permit M-1992-054 Notice of Receipt, Technical Revision TR-4

Mrs. Koenig:

On April 27, 2017, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Technical Revision application **TR-4** and the required fee for the Ignacio Pit Permit **M-1992-054**, which is located in La Plata County. The revision requested addresses the following items:

- *Alter reclamation plan allowing for the importation of inert offsite fill in Phase A, and allow a stock pond in Phase D*

Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application;

1. The importation of offsite fill material such as concrete and hydrovac materials are allowed under Rule 3.1.5. In order to incorporate this into the permit the Operator must submit an affidavit in compliance with Rule 3.1.5 (9). In addition to the requirements of Rule 3.1.5 (9) the affidavit shall include a commitment to cut off and remove all protruding re-bar or steel reinforcements from the broken pieces of concrete, bending the reinforcements to eliminate migration to the surface is not sufficient.

For the hydrovac material to be deposited on site, the Operator must submit a signed commitment certifying that all hydrovac material will be clean and inert. The Operator must also commit to sampling the material of every 100th load for chemical analysis by a qualified analytical laboratory and supply those results to the Division. The affidavit shall also include a map identifying the area that is to be backfilled using the imported materials.

2. Please provide a Map showing the location of the proposed stock pond within Phase D as well as a narrative describing the size of the pond in acres, as well as the volume of the proposed pond. Also please provide documentation that the landowner does own the water rights sufficient to fill the pond.

Please submit the requested information within **30 Days** of the date of this letter. The information should be received by the Division's Denver Office no later than **June 1, 2017**. If the information is not received the Technical Revision may be denied. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions, comments or
