The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (CDRMS) has reviewed and found the above referenced report to be in compliance with the following CDRMS regulation(s):

4.05.9(17) - Examined at least quarterly by a qualified person designated by the operator, for appearance of structural weakness and other hazardous conditions.

4.05.9(17) - A copy of the report shall be submitted to the Division on a quarterly basis.

The first quarter pond inspection report was received by the Division on 21 April 2017 via email. Pond inspections were conducted by WWC Engineering on 15 March 2017.

It is noted that both ponds 001 and 002 were dry at the time of the inspections. No maintenance items were noted. The Division has no adequacy comments concerning this report.
