Mr. Bloess:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) has reviewed the application for a technical revision to the above referenced 112c permit. The technical revision proposes to upgrade sediment control structures for basin M001 and replace damaged and undersized culverts under the mine haul road. A review of the application has revealed a few clarifications required to process the technical revision:

- 1) Please provide a larger sized conceptual design drawings. The figures provided are too small and are not legible.
- 2) Please commit to providing the division "as built" drawings once the improvements have been completed.

The technical revision cannot be approved until the issues are adequately addressed. Please submit a response to the issues as soon as possible but no later than May 17, 2017, so the decision date of May 24, 2017 can be met. If your response, or a written request for an extension of the decision date, is not received by May 17, 2017 the request for the revision may be denied.
