

#### First Quarter 2017 Pond Inspection Report Review

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (CDRMS) has reviewed and found the above referenced report to be in compliance with the following CDRMS regulation(s):

4.05.9(17) - Examined at least quarterly by a qualified person designated by the operator, for appearance of structural weakness and other hazardous conditions.

4.05.9(17) - A copy of the report shall be submitted to the Division on a quarterly basis.

The first quarter pond inspection report was received by the Division on May 2, 2017. Pond inspections were conducted by Scott Wanstedt of BME on March 30, 2017.

It is noted that discharge was only observed from the raw water lagoon and the B-Seam dewatering ponds. The Division understands that, based on the information in the report, seepage at the SDH-3U process pond was observed. The Division has no adequecy comments concerning this report.

### First Quarter 2017 County Road #65 Subsidence Report Review

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (CDRMS) have found the above referenced report to be in compliance with the requirements of C-1981-081 unless noted below.

Longwall mining occurred under RCR #65 during the quarter with only superficial surface impacts observed and no significant damage that would warrant repairs. These observations reflect the Division's observations during the on-the-ground inspections conducted during the first quarter 2017.
