PUBLIC NOTICE Proposed Mining Operation The City of Sterling, 421 N. 4th Street, Sterling, Colorado has submitted an Application Amendment for Limited Impact Operations (110) for the Rothe Sand and Gravel Pit in Logan County. The site is located in Section 33, Township 8, Range 52, SW Quarter Section, NE Quarter/Quarter Section. The amendment application was reviewed for completeness on May 8, 2017. The amendment includes a change in property description, additional mining of materials, and change in post-mining land use to recreation. The two existing pits will be expanded and connected into one gravel pit that will remain after mining to be used for recreation. Removal of the gravel under the amendment will commence in August of 2017 and be completed by August 31, 2018. Additional information may be obtained by contacting Mr. Donald J.
