**Re: Notice of Continuance, Big "G" Gravel Pit, Permit No. M-2006-081**

Dear Daniel J. Gaudreault and Barbara J. Gaudreault:

On April 4, 2017, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) notified you that the Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board) would hold an Enforcement Hearing for the Big "G" Gravel Pit, Permit M-2006-081, at the May 24-25, 2017 Board Meeting. The Enforcement Hearing was scheduled for the Board's consideration of a possible violation, cease and desist order, corrective action, and civil penalties for failure to first obtain a reclamation permit from the Board before engaging in a new mining operation (considers mining more than two acres outside of the approved permit boundary as a violation for mining without a permit). Following your May 19, 2017 request, the Board has continued the Enforcement Hearing to the June 28-29, 2017 Board Meeting.

Therefore, an Enforcement Hearing will be held during the **June 28-29, 2017 Board Meeting**. The hearing will be held in Room 318 of 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on June 28, 2017 or as soon thereafter as the matter can be considered.

The Board's agenda may not be finalized until the week of the Board meeting.
