OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Dennis and Lucy Cordova, representing the Operator, and Rebecca Morris, representing the BLM, were present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Lickskillet Claims NOI site is located on federal lands managed by the BLM, approximately 9.5 miles east of Manassa and accessed from Hwy 142. The site is approved for a 1.5 acre disturbance area within a historically disturbed area of around 30 acres. The NOI authorizes sorting through pre-law mine spoils, procuring turquoise specimens, and backfilling pre-law pits and portals with the re-worked spoils. Based on the conditions observed during this inspection, the Prospector appears to operating in accordance with the conditions approved by the NOI.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.

The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$3,525.90 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is adequate.
