Gentlemen:

It has come to our attention that the permit M2015017 should not have been issued.

Issues identified in a letter from Park County Planning dated 12/09/2015 apparently were never addressed by the mine operator.

The issues include:

- 1. Permit area includes land designated as significant wildlife habitat.
- 2. Portions of the permit land area include areas zoned Residential.
- 3. Sewage, waste management, and signage concerns.
- 4. CDOT access permit.
- 5. Required Floodplain Development Permit.

Please note that just the single issue of residential zoned land within the permit boundary should have resulted in the denial of the permit, as the land was never re-zoned.

We request that the DRMS issue a cease and desist order and STOP THIS ILLEGAL MINING ACTIVITY IMMEDIATELY.

I also request that you acknowledge receipt of this email, and notify me of actions taken by the DRMS to remedy the situation.
