COMMENTS

This was a complete inspection of the New Horizon Mine conducted by Brock Bowles of the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety. Frank Ferris of Elk Ridge Mining and Reclamation was present for the entire inspection. The weather conditions were mostly sunny and dry. The temperature was approximately 95F and the ground was dry.

AVAILABILITY OF RECORDS – Rule 5.02.4(1):

The records were checked after the ground inspection. All required records were on file and available for review at the mine office. No problems were noted with the records review. Please see the availability of records checklist at the end of this report.

HYDROLOGIC BALANCE - Rule 4.05

Drainage Control 4.05.1, 4.05.2, 4.05.3; Siltation Structures 4.05.5, 4.05.6; Discharge Structures 4.05.7, 4.05.10; Diversions 4.05.4; Effluent Limits 4.05.2; Ground Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Surface Water Monitoring 4.05.13; Drainage – Acid and Toxic Materials 4.05.8; Impoundments 4.05.6, 4.05.9; Stream Buffer Zones 4.05.18: Pond 007 contained water and was discharging. The CO2 aerator was in operation (photo 1).

Pond 009 did not contain water. The discharge structure was free and clear of obstructions. The rocks that were noted blocking ditch C23 and the C118 culverts in the Oct 2016 inspection report have been repaired.

Pond 012 contained water but was not discharging. The discharge structure was free and clear of obstructions.

Pond 013 contained water and was discharging. The trench drain was also discharging (photo 2). The emergency culverts and discharge structure were free and clear of obstructions.

Ponds 15 and 16 did not contain water.

The culverts 119 thru 124 were free and clear of obstructions.

The spillway structure on the NW corner of the Morgan property was in good condition. The wattles on the north and west property line were in good condition. The Enstrom irrigation water was flowing in the irrigation ditch and through the culvert to the north side of the BB Road.

RECLAMATION SUCCESS - Rule 4.15, Rule 3:

Some patches of knapweed were noted on the north embankment of Pond 9, the SE inlet of Pond 9, along the old BB Road Detour on the Benson East property and on the west side of the Pond 015 (photo 3). Knapweed is a noxious weed and needs to be treated.

A large patch of Canada thistle was noted on the western edge of the Morgan alfalfa field (photo 4). Canada thistle is a noxious weed and needs to be treated. The treatment method will have to be coordinated with the Morgans.

REVEGETATION – Rule 4.15

Vegetative Cover; Timing:

The vegetation on the irrigated pasture reference area was recently cut and baled. The ERMR staff was weighing the bales during this inspection.

The vegetation on the south side of 5th Rd was being baled into small square bales (photo 5).

The vegetation in the irrigated pastures on the north side of 5th Rd was being cut and baled (photo 6). The areas where the bales have already been removed were being irrigated.

A topsoil depression was repaired on the Morgan field. The repair is located along the BB Road (photo 7).

SIGNS AND MARKERS – Rule 4.02:

The permit boundary signs were installed around the new topsoil location on the Slash M property (photo 8).

The permit boundary signs were in place along the northern boundary between 2700 Road and Pond 12 and along both side of 5th Road and BB Road.

Permit boundary signs were in place along the western boundary north of Pond 015.

TOPSOIL - Rule 4.06

Removal 4.06.2; Substitute Materials 4.06.4(4); Storage and Protection 4.06.3; Redistribution 4.06.4:

The Morgan topsoil pile Lift A was being moved from the ERMR-Johnson property by Pond 16 to the Morgan (Slash M) property (photos 8 & 9). The topsoil was approved to be relocated in TR79. The Lift B pile will be moved after the A lift relocation is complete.

The topsoil ring ditch was being repaired on the western side of stockpile 12 (photo 10). The ring ditch was

damaged during the relocation of the Morgan topsoil piles.

ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS/COMPLIANCE

No enforcement actions were initiated as a result of this inspection, nor are any pending.
