#### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Van 4 Shaft is located approximately ten miles west of Naturita and accessed from Dd19 Rd. The site is a 110d operation that includes a total of 8.4 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$75,057.00 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was located on the hoist building, which is visible from the site entrance.

This site is currently in temporary cessation. The hoist building, hoist and shop are still located on site. No storage of hazardous materials was noted.

The shaft is secured with fencing and a padlocked gate.

An infestation of Russian knapweed was noted between the hoist house and shaft. These noxious weeds should be treated as soon as possible.

The drainage ditch adjacent to the county road appeared in good condition.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.


