The Division has identified several other comments and questions that must be addressed prior to the Division's decision due date.

1. Pursuant to Rule 3.1.5(3), all grading shall be done in a manner to control erosion and siltation of the affected lands, to protect areas outside of the affected land from slides and other damage. Please describe the best management practices which will be utilized to prevent sediment from leaving the site during construction of the access road on the north side of the river.

Please remember that the decision date for this Technical Revision is July 26, 2017. If you are unable to provide satisfactory responses to any inadequacies prior to this date, it will be your responsibility to request an extension of time to allow for continued review of this Technical Revision. If there are still unresolved issues when the decision date arrives and no extension has been requested, the Technical Revision will be denied.
