RE: Black Hawk Towing; DRMS File No. M-2017-028; Notice of Removal of Cease and Desist Order

On June 23, 2017, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) issued a Cease and Desist Order for Black Hawk Towing, its associates, and/or its receiver to immediately cease and desist all mining, prospecting, milling, exploration, and other mining operations at the above-referenced site or at any off-site areas. The cease and desist was issued as a result of citizen complaints filed with the Division which indicated emergency conditions existed at the Black Hawk Towing property which resulted in an immediate and undue risk of serious harm to persons, property, or the environment.

The Division conducted an inspection of the Black Hawk Towing property on June 23, 2017 and determined that no mining or mining related activity was occurring. Therefore, the Division hereby lifts the Cease and Desist Order which was issued on June 23, 2017.
