## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety. The Midwest Exploration Project is a 0.80 acre prospecting drilling project. Rio Grande Silver, Inc. mine manager Randy McClure was present during the inspection.

The operator stated that future drilling is planned. No reclamation will occur in the next few years.

No erosion or sedimentation issues were noted. There are no major or minor drainage issues within the prospect area that warrant addressing.

No noxious weeds were observed.
