EXHIBIT C - Mining Plan (Rule 6.3.3)

25. Within the response to Adequacy Item 10, the proposed excavations will not exceed 20 feet in depth. In lieu of engineering stability analyses for proposed mining slopes, as required by Rule 6.5(2), please commit to maintaining a 3H:1V ratio for distance from the permit boundary to depth of excavation (i.e an excavation of 20 feet should be no closer to the permit boundary than 60 feet). This commitment will help ensure protection of off-site lands in accordance with C.R.S. 34-32-116(7)(h). Please note, as mining progresses, the Applicant may submit a Technical Revision to the permit addressing slope stability analyses to allow excavations near the permit boundary.

Response: We commit to maintaining a 3H:1V ratio for distance from the permit boundary to depth of excavation (i.e an excavation of 20 feet should be no closer to the permit boundary than 60 feet). We also understand that as mining progresses, we may submit a Technical Revision to the permit addressing slope stability analyses to allow excavations near the permit boundary.
