Dear Daniel J. Gaudreault and Barbara J. Gaudreault,

The Division received the response in regards to the remaining Compliance Problems identified in the May 18, 2017 inspection report of the Big "G" Gravel Pit. The status of the corrective actions are listed below.

- **COMPLIANCE PROBLEM #1:** Approved storm water control and sedimentation prevention methods have not been implemented or have not been constructed appropriately.
 - On August 14, 2017, the Operator's submitted photographic documentation showing a storm water control berm has been constructed in the area of concern; **this problem has been resolved**.
- **COMPLIANCE PROBLEM #2:** An open test pit poses a threat to wildlife/livestock.
 - On August 14, 2017, the Operator's submitted photographic documentation showing the test pit has been; **this problem has been resolved**.
