## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety. The Bird Creek Mine is an abandoned mine that was closed by the DRMS Inactive Mine Program. The Bird Creek Mine is located approximately 1.3 miles southeast of Spar City Colorado off of U.S. Forest Service Road 528.

The Division was notified that there may be a stockpile of mining related hazardous chemicals being stored on the site. The purpose of the inspection was to verify if the reports were valid. Division staff determined no hazardous materials were located at the mine site. Two historical storage buildings were observed and the buildings were empty.

No evidence of mining related activity was observed during the inspection.
