On October 2, 2017 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your letter requesting an extension to post the additional financial warranty amount of \$20,113. This surety increase was in response to the approval of TR-2, which was approved on March 15, 2017. TR-2 involved revising the reclamation plan and making a commitment to doing reclamation activities in the spring of 2017.

In your letter you have stated that the mining area has been reclaimed down to 5 acres. In order for us to consider a re-evaluation of the bond, additional information will be needed. Please send the Division list of what tasks have been completed verse what task are still remaining. If a portion of the task remains, please give the amount (ie. Length of highwall remaining to grade). Also please provide photo documentation of the work completed.

All additional documentation must be submitted and received to the Division **no later than October 16, 2017**. If the necessary information is not received on or before October 16, 2017 then the item will appear before the MLRB at the October 25, 2017 meeting.
