Re: Response to Inert Fill Notice Pueblo East Pit, File No. M-1986-015 Grisenti Farms Pit, File No. M-2001-005

Dear Mr. Laroche,

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has received your two notices and requests to import clean waste construction material to the sites listed above. Please re-submit these requests as separate Technical Revisions (TR) to each permit in accordance with Rule 1.9 and submit the appropriate TR fee of \$216.00 each. This proposal will currently be assigned as TR-04 for the Pueblo East Pit and TR-02 for the Grisenti Farms Pit. The Division has enclosed a copy of a TR Cover Sheet.

Upon a preliminary review of the submittals, the Division has identified the following concerns which will need to be addressed in the re-submittal or during the subsequent adequacy review of the TRs.

- In accordance 3.1.5(9)(c), provide an affidavit, signed by the permittee, certifying all imported material is clean and inert.
- Either remove the section of the importation certification referencing asphalt paving fragments or address the importation of aged asphalt and commit to placing it at least two feet above the static ground water elevation.
