

There are two holes that are planned to be drilled inside the Seifert quarry permit area. One is not in the active pit area, and will be reclaimed in accordance with the procedures outlined in the 2016-019 NOI Prospecting Permit Modification.

The other hole is planned to be drilled in the active pit area will be reclaimed according to the procedures described in the 2016-0019 NOI modification, with the exception that there is no topsoil in the active pit area, and no re-seeding will be done, as this would interfere with the quarry operations.
