Dear Ms. Griffin,

On October 11, 2017, Park County notified the Division that they no longer have a legal right of entry onto the Sulphur Mtn. Gravel Pit for the purpose of mining and reclamation. As required by Rule 6.3.7, Park County shall maintain a legal right of entry for the life of the mining operation. Failure to maintain a legal right of entry does not relieve Park County from their responsibility to ensure all affected lands are reclaimed in accordance with the approved Reclamation Plan. This matter has been cited as a problem and will require corrective action. Park County shall provide the Division with an updated legal right of entry onto the mine site within 60 days of the date of this letter (December 12, 2017).
