Dear Mr. Newman,

On October 11, 2017 the Division received the incomplete Application for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators. The following items are required for the application to be filed and processed:

1. The Applicants maintained their right to a decision within 30 days. In this case, the Prospective Successor must submit a conditional replacement Financial Warranty in the amount of \$4,339,003.39. Alternately, the Applicants may waive their right to a decision within 30 days, in which case the Financial Warranty shall be submitted after the Division has completed an evaluation of the required Financial Warranty amount.
2. The Prospective Successor must demonstrate they have obtained a legal right of entry from any and all surface and mineral rights owners of the affected lands. This may be a copy of an access lease, deed, abstract of title, current tax receipt, or a signed and notarized statement by the property owners stating that the Prospective Successor has a legal right to enter.

Please return the required documentation to the Division on or before December 11, 2017. If the requested documentation is not submitted within 60 days, the application may be terminated.
